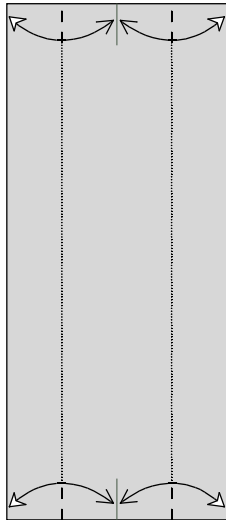




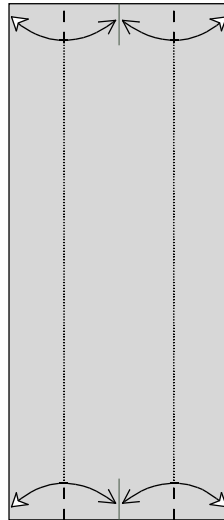
# Money Wheat Head



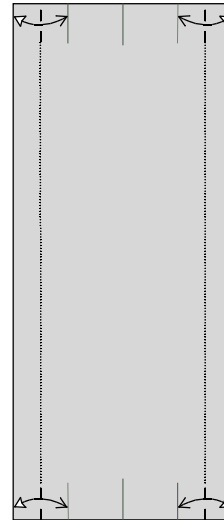
1. Begin with the face side up. Fold the bill in half the long way, making a light crease in the middle at the top and bottom edges; then unfold.



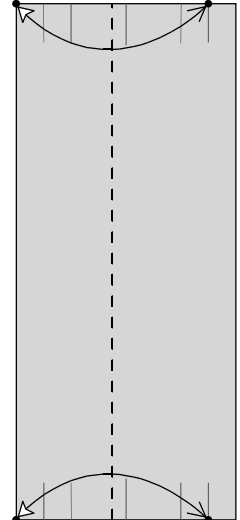
2. Fold the long edges in to the creases you just made; again make light creases at top and bottom and unfold.



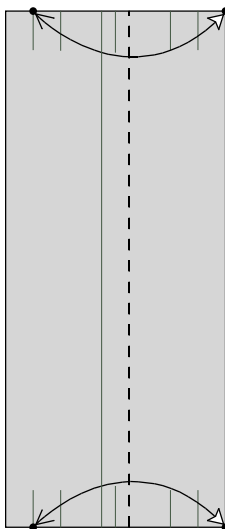
3. Again, fold the long edges in to the creases you just made; again make light creases at top and bottom and unfold.



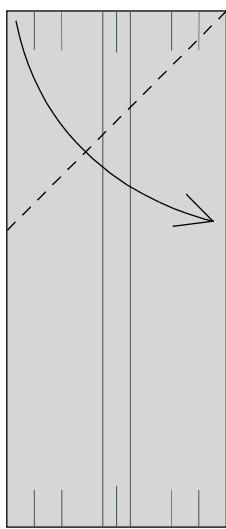
4. And one more time.



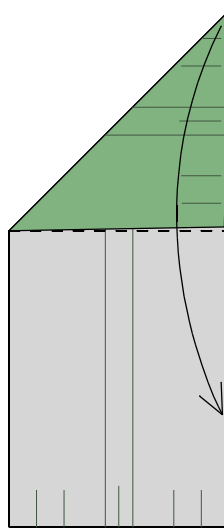
5. Fold the left edge over to the rightmost pair of creases; this time make the crease sharp all the way down. Unfold.



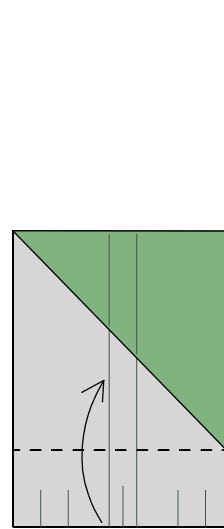
6. Repeat with the right edge.



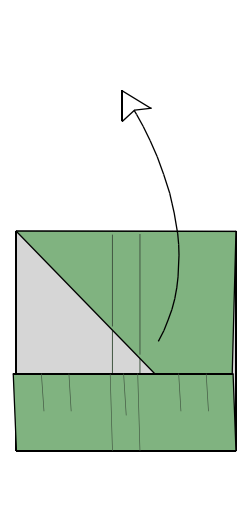
7. Fold the top edge down to lie along the right edge.



8. Fold the top right corner down along a fold that aligns with the raw edge.



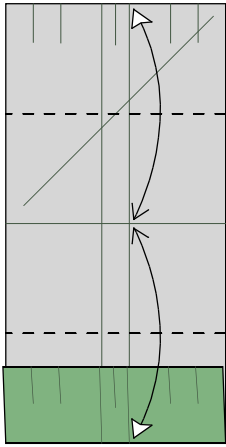
9. Fold the bottom edge up along a fold aligned with the corner along the left side.



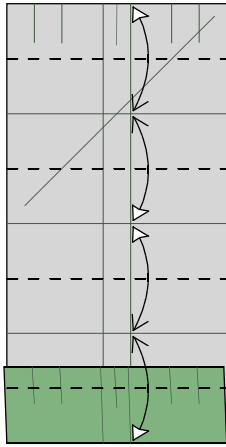
10. Unfold the top flap completely (but leave the bottom folded up).



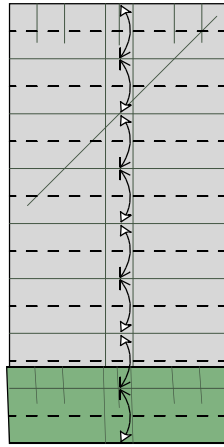

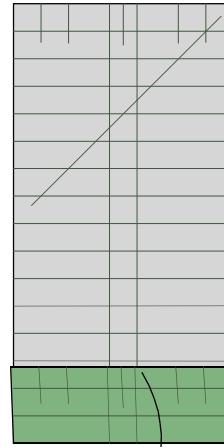
11. The bill now consists of two squares separated by a crease. Fold each square in half; crease firmly, and unfold.



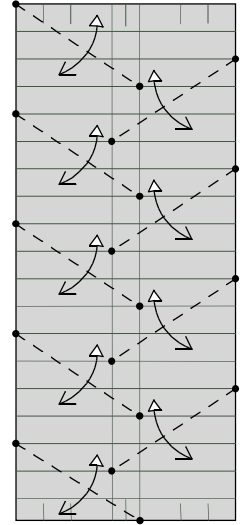
12. Divide each of the resulting rectangular panels in half by folding and unfolding.



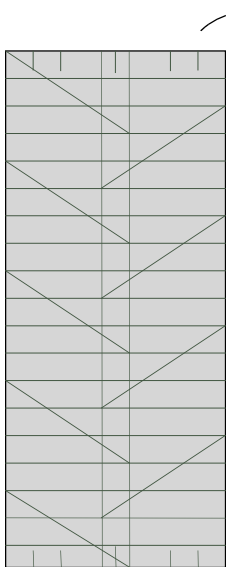
13. And again.



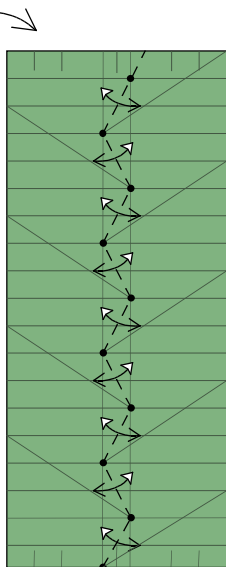
14. Unfold the bottom flap.



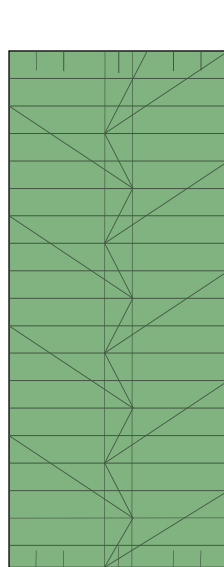
15. Create creases that connect the points shown. These creases should be very sharp; run your fingernail over them as you make each one, then unfold.



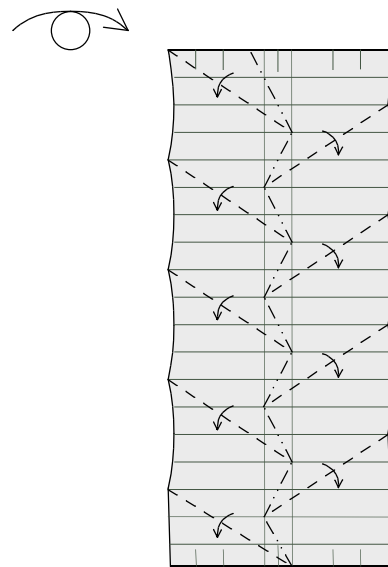
16. Turn the paper over from side to side.



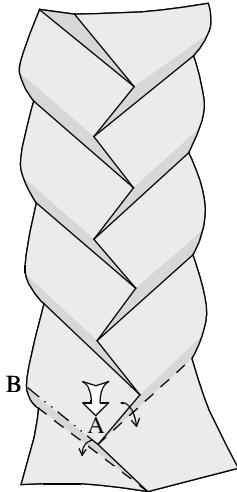
17. Make a crease between each pair of points shown. Again, make each crease sharp before unfolding.



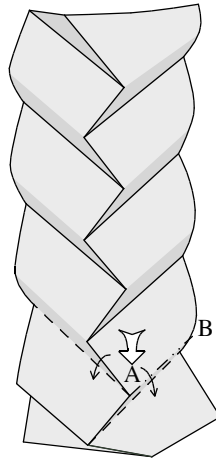
18. Turn the paper over again.



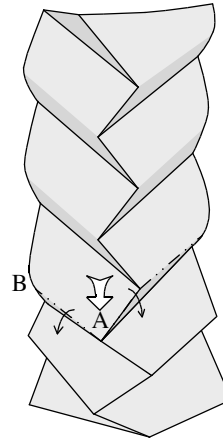
18. Fold each of the creases from steps 15 and 17 a little bit in the direction that they were started, so that the creases of step 17 form a raised zig-zag in the middle of the paper and the creases from step 15 form shallow valleys running out toward the sides. Curve the paper between those valleys so that there are rounded "hills" between the sharp valleys.



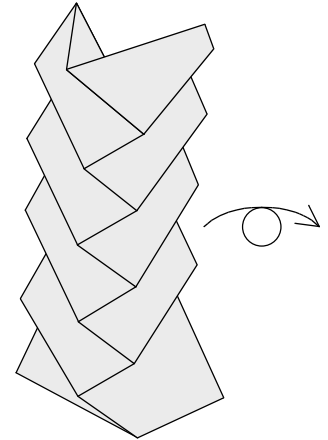
19. Press down the corner marked A, then slide your finger from A to B, forming a new crease and flattening the bottom part of the paper.



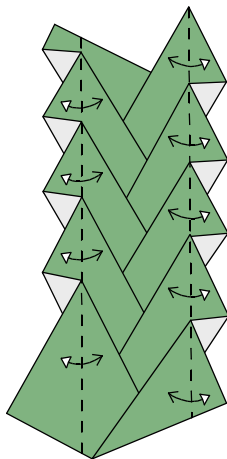
20. Press down the next corner up, also marked A, then slide your finger from A to B, forming a new crease and flattening the bottom part of the paper in the same way as in step 19.



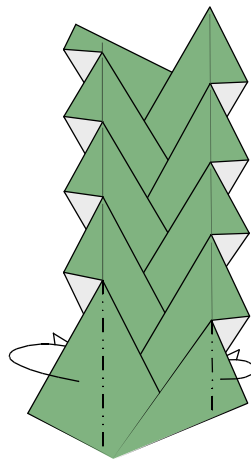
21. Continue, working your way up the paper. When you are done, everything should lie flat.



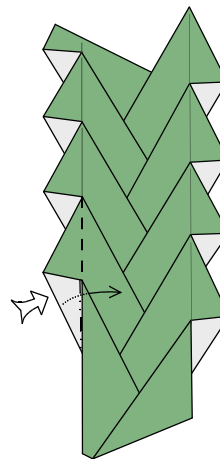
22. Press firmly flat, then turn the paper over from side to side.



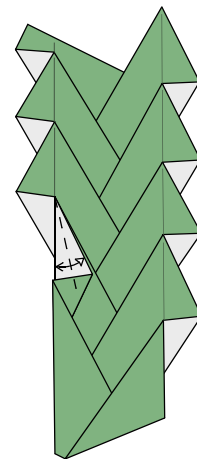
23. Fold the sides in through all layers along a vertical fold that goes through the upwardpointing triangle tips on each side. Crease firmly; then unfold.



24. Fold the two bottom corners behind on the existing creases.



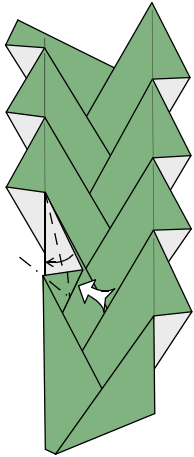
25. Push in the corner so that its layers go between the two upwardpointing triangles.



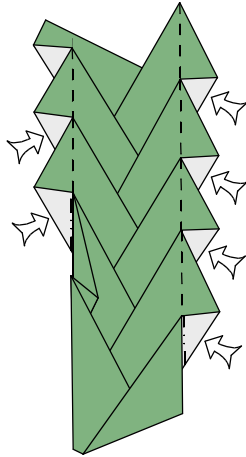
26. Fold the raw edge out to the vertical folded edge; crease firmly and unfold.



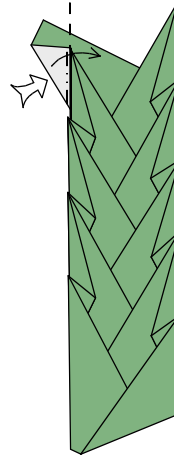

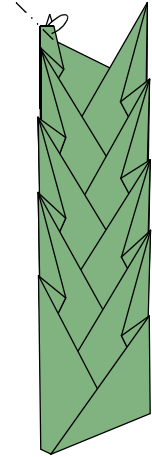
27. Using the crease you just made, push in the edge so that it goes between the two points, forming a new crease that runs to the near point.



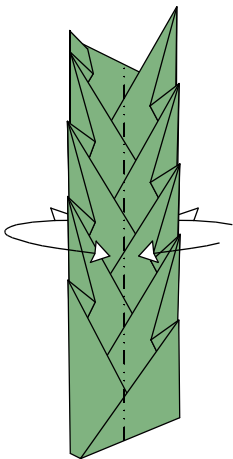
28. Repeat steps 25-27 in six more places.



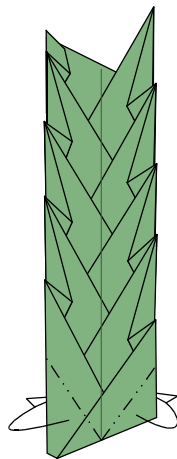
29. Push the edge in between the layers as you did in steps 25-27, but note that the top will not form a point.



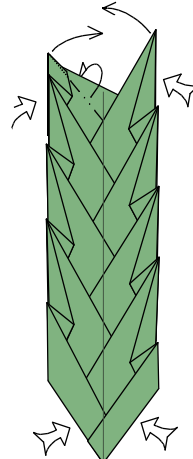
30. Fold the tip of the corner behind.



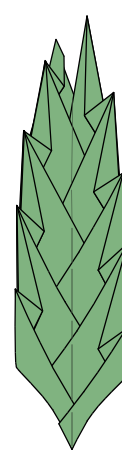
31. Fold in half through all layers, folding the edges away from you; then unfold.



32. Fold the two bottom corners behind.



33. Pinch the top end together and fold an edge behind. Curve the head so that it becomes 3D.



34. Finished wheat head.
